

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

OF MEMBERSHIP OF THE NORTH COTSWOLDS BUSINESS GROUP CIC.

- These terms and conditions are the contract between the North Cotswolds Business Group('NCBG') company number 13370267 and its Members.
- Members are organisations who either pay to join the NCBG or are provided with membership on a complimentary basis.
- By applying for membership of the NCBG potential members agree to these terms and conditions.
- Membership of the NCBG entitles Members to the services set out on the NCBG website www.northcotswoldsbusinessgroup.co.uk
- These services may be amended by NCBG. Any changes made will be set out on the website from time to time.
- Payment for a NCBG membership is for one year. Members may cancel membership of the NCBG at any time within 28 days of paying their subscription. This is the 'cooling off' period. If this right is exercised, the membership fee will be returned in full.
- Subscriptions are non-refundable after the 'cooling off' period.
- Members may not transfer their membership to any other person or organisation.
- The NCBG reserve the right to modify the NCBG membership rules or system and to change the terms and conditions of this agreement at any time, without notice.
- Continued use of the NCBG membership after such modifications shall be deemed an acceptance by Members that they be bound by the terms of the modified agreement.
- All modifications will be posted on the NCBG website.
- The price of NCBG membership is set out on the NCBG website, and the fee is inclusive of any applicable value added tax or other sales tax.
- From time to time the NCBG may organise events that are not covered by the annual subscription. In these cases, additional fees will apply if Members wish to attend these events.
- Membership fees will be collected via the Go Cardless platform. Two weeks before expiry of the annual membership, a renewal notice for the next contract period will be sent to the Members at their last known email address. The notice will explain that the NCBG membership is to expire shortly, and should the Member not wish to renew their membership they must inform the NCBG at least seven days before the renewal date.
- From time to time the NCBG will feature Members on its social media platforms. Becoming a Member of the NCBG means that Members accept this clause.
- The NCBG will comply with the Data Protection Act 2018 in relation to use of Member's data.
- Members agree to provide accurate, up to date, and complete information about themselves and will notify the NCBG of any changes immediately.
